Upon enrolment of the student at Yago School Málaga, the parents or legal guardians declare that they **fully understand and accept the School's current Terms and Conditions**.

The School, for its part, agrees to **offer a place to the named student** and to **provide an education in accordance with the School's philosophy and principles**, as set out in its official publications.

Likewise, the parents/legal guardians state that they **have the responsibility and authority to manage all matters relating to the student, including the payment of school fees**.

The parents/legal guardians acknowledge that they **will be jointly and severally liable** to the School for compliance with all obligations set out in this document.

This document shall be **valid from the date the enrolment fee is paid** until the student completes their education at Yago School Málaga, or until it is **terminated early** by the School or by the parents/legal guardians in accordance with these conditions.

1. The place is reserved **once the admissions process has been completed, the initial payments have been made and the required documentation has been submitted**.
2. The parents/legal guardians undertake to provide, at the time of application, **all relevant academic, medical, psychological, personal or social information. Omission, concealment or falsification** of such information shall entitle the School to **cancel the current enrolment or refuse its renewal, without the right to a refund of any amounts paid**.
3. **Non-renewal of enrolment** for a new academic year shall be at the **exclusive discretion of the School**, provided there is justified cause.
4. The parents/legal guardians must **pay all school and boarding fees within the established deadlines. Late payments** may result in the **student being suspended from activities or examinations**.
5. The **boarding deposit** will **only be refunded** if the stipulated conditions are met and upon submission of the **withdrawal and refund form signed by the Headship. Fees are non-refundable** in cases of **disciplinary expulsion, temporary absences, or withdrawal without the required notice**.
6. The student will **fully participate in all aspects of the School's curriculum**. The parents/legal guardians will **ensure compliance with the School's rules and support the School** in its educational work.
7. As a condition of entry or continued attendance, the parents/legal guardians will **assume the cost of additional language or learning support**, when so recommended by the School.

8. **Students joining from PYP 5 onwards must take compulsory Chinese reinforcement. Reinforcement in English or Spanish as a foreign language will be compulsory from PYP 4, if recommended by the School.**
9. For students coming from foreign education systems, **placement will be determined based on date of birth.**
10. **Decisions regarding the allocation of available places are the exclusive responsibility of the Senior Leadership Team, at its discretion, without the possibility of external influence.**
11. The School may **suspend or expel the student, temporarily or permanently**, in the event of serious breaches of the regulations or the code of conduct. Likewise, **enrolment will not be renewed** in cases of **serious disciplinary incidents, outstanding debts at the end of the academic year, or repeated breaches of conduct rules.**
12. The School has a **zero-tolerance policy** regarding the **use of drugs and alcohol**. Failure to comply with this rule will result in the **immediate expulsion** of the student.
13. **Regular attendance is compulsory.** Unjustified absences of more than 5 days per term, or 10 days across the academic year, may result in the cancellation of the student's place.
14. The student will be **covered by an accident insurance policy** during school hours and in extracurricular activities.
15. In the event of medical emergencies, the parents/legal guardians **authorise the School to administer necessary treatment and make urgent decisions** when they cannot be contacted.
16. The School may **significantly modify the curriculum, fees or organisation**, providing **adequate prior notice.**
17. The parents/legal guardians are **responsible for the student's personal belongings**. The School **accepts no responsibility for loss or damage.**
18. The School will **share academic information with the parents/legal guardians**, unless legally restricted.
19. The School **reserves the right to reassign unconfirmed places when the reservation fee has not been paid within the established deadlines.**
20. By **formalising the enrolment**, the parents/legal guardians **implicitly accept these regulations, the School's ethos and all current rules.**
21. In the event of a **temporary or permanent closure of the School due to force majeure** (pandemics, terrorism or others), **there will be no right to a refund of fees.**
22. **Place Reservation:** In March, families of currently enrolled students must confirm their child's place for the following academic year by paying the place reservation fee. The amount paid will be deducted from the September tuition invoice for the new academic year.
23. The place reservation fee is **non-refundable**. In the event that a family withdraws or cancels their child's enrolment, neither the place reservation fee nor the enrolment fee will be refunded. Likewise, any payments made in advance are non-refundable, except in cases of duly justified circumstances accepted by the School.
24. **Educational Support Department:** The fee charged for assessments carried out by the Educational Support Department covers all assessments scheduled throughout the student's time at the School and is **non-refundable**.
25. The purchase of the School uniform, school materials and textbooks is compulsory and must be made through the School.
